

## 2014-16 Community Health Plan

## Posted May 15, 2014

Park Ridge Health conducted/participated in a broad Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA) in 2013 under the umbrella of Western North Carolina (WNC) Health Impact, a partnership among county health departments and hospitals. (See <u>www.WNCHealthyImpact.com</u> for more details about the assessment, purpose and participants in this region-wide effort.)

Park Ridge Health is a leader in Healthy Impact as well as a leader in the development of the Community Health Needs Assessment – as were the Henderson County Health Department and multiple other community partners<sup>i</sup>. The Assessment looked at the health-related needs of the broad community as well as those of low-income, minority and underserved populations. The Assessment included both primary and secondary data, and identified the following priorities:

- Improve Women's Health During Childbearing Years
- Promote Healthy Weight and Healthy Living
- Improve Children's Health Outcomes through a Focus on Family Support and Education
- Increase Readiness of all Children to Learn and Succeed in School
- Access to and Continuity of a Primary Care Home
- Access to and Continuity of a Mental Health Home

After conducting the Community Health Needs Assessment, Park Ridge Health and the other partners developed the Henderson County Health Improvement Plan<sup>ii</sup>, or "implementation strategy. The hospital's Community Health Needs Assessment Committee participants, hospital leadership and the hospital board reviewed the needs identified in the Assessment. The hospital Board approved the priorities and the full Assessment.

Next, with a particular focus on these priorities, the community partnership helped developed a Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP) or "implementation strategy<sup>iii</sup>." The CHIP has been approved by the Park Ridge Health Board and posted by May 15, 2014 at the web location noted below. The Plan lists targeted interventions and measurable outcome statements for each effort. Many interventions engage multiple community partners. This supplemental document describes the activities and outcomes measures for the specific parts of the Plan in which Park Ridge Health is taking a lead role.

Park Ridge Health's fiscal year is January-December. For 2014, the Community Health Improvement Plan will be deployed beginning May 15 and evaluated at the end of the calendar year. In 2015 and beyond, the CHIP will be evaluated annually for the 12-month period beginning January 1 and ending December 31. Evaluation results will be posted annually and attached to our IRS Form 990.
