2023 AdventHealth Heart, Lung and Vascular Institute

AdventHealth Heart, Lung and Vascular Institute

The AdventHealth Heart, Lung and Vascular Institute (HLVI) is the largest provider of cardiovascular care in Florida, with over 300 experts and 15 subspecialties. In Central Florida alone, AdventHealth performs more cardiothoracic and vascular surgeries than any other facility in the U.S., serving more than 72,000 patients each year, including more than 4,500 who undergo heart surgery.

Access and Volume Achievements

Patient access to quality care is HLVI's priority. In 2023, AdventHealth expanded services and programs across our Central Florida campuses, resulting in improved access for our patients both in person and virtually.

- Virtual Care Centers provided remote patient monitoring, 24/7 cardiac telemetry and nearly 11,000 visits.
- AdventHealth Celebration completed its 1,000th CABG since the program's inception in 2019.
- AdventHealth Orlando's TAVR program reached a milestone of 2,500 procedures.
- The AdventHealth Trina Hidalgo Heart Center, the only clinic of its kind in Central Florida providing care to underserved patients, saw a year over year increase of 30 percent with 2,896 visits in 2023.

New Physicians

HLVI recruited 16 new physicians and 20 advanced practice providers across the Central Florida Division.

Programs

HLVI is committed to developing new programs and improving care for the communities we serve.

Highlights from 2023 include:

• Launched Ion Robotics at AdventhHealth Orlando, improving early detection for lung cancer. Cardiovascular Genetics and Genomics started CV-focused genetic counseling to identify, treat and prevent cardiovascular events in patients and family members who are genetically at risk of heart disease. Additionally, this program expanded into pharmacogenomics to analyze how the genetic makeup of a patient affects their response to drugs.

Governance and Subcommittees

AdventHealth Cancer Institute

The AdventHealth Cancer Institute is the largest provider of cancer care in the state of Florida with over 250 medical oncologists, surgical oncologists and radiation oncologists serving more than 21,000 patients a year. AdventHealth's footprint spans across 15 cancer centers and offers subspecialty programs for more than 10 disease sites.

Facilities and Technology

AdventHealth strives to provide comprehensive, worldclass cancer care close to home in the communities we serve. In 2023, AdventHealth successfully expanded access to critical cancer services with new construction projects and state-of-the-art technology at multiple locations across Central Florida, including:

- Apopka Opened a new infusion center with onsite lab and pharmacy
- Altamonte Springs and Lake Mary Expanded the oncology clinic, added clinical research/lab infrastructure and added additional infusion chairs
- Orlando Started renovation on the Cancer Center and Innovation Tower for expanding oncology programs and new physicians
- Orlando Opened the new state-of-the-art cellular therapy laboratory
- Osceola Approved funding to expand radiation oncology services with two new linear accelerators
- Winter Park Expanded the oncology clinic and infusion space (slated to be complete 2024)

New Physicians

The Cancer Institute has continued to grow our expert team of clinicians across the Central Florida Division with 14 new physicians and more than 20 advanced practice providers coming onboard in 2023, including several key leadership positions dedicated to subspecialty program growth.

Program Developments

The highest priorities for patients seeking cancer care are (1) that their doctor is an expert in their cancer type and (2) that they have access to coordinated, multidisciplinary care. With these demands top of mind, AdventHealth has expanded subspecialty oncology programs with expert physician leadership, multidisciplinary care clinics and access to clinical research trials. Key program growth to accomplish this in 2023 included:

- Expansion of the Head and Neck Surgery and Thoracic Surgery programs at Orlando, creating three locations for each of these programs across Central Florida.
- Launch of the Microvascular Reconstructive Surgery Program at Orlando, which led to the first breast neurotization immediately postmastectomy procedure and the first four flap breast reconstructive procedures in Central Florida, as well as the first pediatric free flap procedure at AdventHealth.
- Inaugural AdventHealth Breast Reconstruction Awareness Day, providing education on breast reconstruction and celebrating cancer survivors.
- Launch of Paxman scalp cooling therapy at Winter Park for chemotherapy patients at risk for alopecia.
- HEAL (Healthy Eating Active Lifestyle), AdventHealth's comprehensive lifestyle medicine-based survivorship program, is now available to all cancer patients and has tripled enrollment.
- Expansion of the Immuno-Effector Cell Program, the first in Central Florida, with new CAR-T treatments now including one for multiple myeloma, as well as additional clinical research trials for CAR-T.

- Launch of the Radiation Oncology Theranostic Program with Lutathera and Pluvicto, offering a novel approach that combines diagnostic imaging and radionuclide therapy for a personalized treatment option.
- 14 educational events and 440 tumor boards hosted throughout the year.
- Over 25,000 touchpoints with cancer patients utilizing Nurse Navigation and social work support.

Research and Clinical Trials

The AdventHealth Research Institute increased cuttingedge, multi-phase clinical trials across the Central Florida Division.

 Interventional adult studies were offered in the following tumor sites: bone marrow transplant (BMT), breast, gastrointestinal, genitourinary, gynecologic, hematologic, head and neck, neurologic, radiation oncology, skin and thoracic.

Clinical Quality and Accreditations

AdventHealth Orlando is now ranked by U.S. News & World Report among the top 50 hospitals in the nation for cancer care, earning its highest score ever in 2023. AdventHealth is also recognized as one of Becker's top 60 oncology programs in the nation, due to the expansion of subspecialty expertise, standardization of cancer care and investments in breakthrough research.

AdventHealth Digestive Health Institute

The AdventHealth Digestive Health Institute (DHI) is the largest provider of digestive care in the state of Florida with nearly 170 physicians and 70 employed APPs, providing highly specialized care in gastroenterology, general surgery, colorectal surgery, bariatric surgery, diabetes and endocrinology.

Subspecialty programs include the Center for Esophageal and Swallowing Disorders (CESD), Non-Alcoholic Fatty Liver Disease Program (NAFLD), Inflammatory Bowel Disease Program (IBD), Center for Interventional Endoscopy (CIE), Pancreas Center, Third Space Endoscopy, Endobariatrics, Pelvic Floor Program, Rectal Cancer Program, Advanced Cancer Program and Foregut Program.

New Physicians

In 2023, DHI recruited 10 physicians and 15 advanced practice providers.

New Facilities

In 2023, DHI opened seven additional clinics and facilities to serve multiple communities across Central Florida.

Programs and Education

The continuing development of specialty and graduate programs within DHI allows for innovative, top-quality care. Expansion of these programs provides more access across the community and allows AdventHealth to train the next generation of specialists.

New Programs

- Barrett's and Eosinophilic Esophagitis (EoE) clinic in Orlando.
- Culinary Adventures with Chef Edwin is a live cooking demo promoted as an incentive for completing 10 hours of comprehensive diabetes education.
- WellTogether is a new eight-week multidisciplinary program geared to support community members with chronic disease.

Expansions

- GI subspecialty programs, including Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IBD), Non-Alcoholic Fatty Liver Disease (NAFLD) and the Center for Esophageal and Swallowing Disorders (CESD).
- GI Hospitalist Program expansion to AdventHealth Celebration and AdventHealth East Orlando.
- Pelvic Floor Surgery Programs at AdventHealth East Orlando, AdventHealth Winter Park and AdventHealth Celebration.
- RN Care Navigator Program allows each specialty program to have a dedicated nurse navigator.
- Expansion of direct access options for easier patient connection to colonoscopy screenings.

Education

- ACGME-accredited GI Fellowship Program has grown to five fellows in 2023, with eight fellows in 2024.
- CIE Advanced Endoscopy Fellowship Program expanded to three fellows per year.
- AdventHealth's Colorectal Surgery Fellowship Program grew to six fellows, making the program the largest in the country.

Center for Interventional Endoscopy was the first in the world to perform a pioneering endoscopic procedure dubbed the "Candy Cane," named for the shape of the small bowel.

Events

The team at DHI values the collaboration and community that comes with bringing together providers through continued medical education (CME), courses and retreats. During 2023, a variety of opportunities were offered, both virtually and in person:

- Five CME-accredited conferences:

OurLegacy is the federally designated, nonprofit organ and tissue recovery organization serving the 3.8 million residents of East Central Florida. As one of only seven hospital-owned and operated Organ Procurement Organizations (OPO) in the U.S., we are proud to partner with hospitals and transplant centers throughout our ten-county service area.

OurLegacy is a CMS Designated Tier 1 OPO. A Tier 1 designation indicates OPOs whose donation and transplantation rates are in the top quartile of OPO performance. OurLegacy is the only Florida OPO whose tier status has remained in the upper quartile since CMS began publishing rates in 2021.

In 2023, OurLegacy supported 51 hospital or ER facilities referring organ or tissue donors, including 18 AdventHealth locations. OurLegacy is grateful to partner with physicians, nurses, respiratory therapists, surgical technicians and so many others at hospitals across Central Florida who are dedicated to honoring the gift of life.

Innovations

In 2023 OurLegacy adopted a new means of organ preservation called Normothermic Regional Perfusion (NRP). This method, not yet in use by all OPOs and transplant programs, uses existing ECMO technology that enables a more thorough assessment of organs from donation after circulatory death (DCD) donors to determine if they are safe to transplant. The ECMO technology allows organs to be assessed after a donor's heart has stopped and the ECMO machine re-institutes circulation. ECMO circulation is applied for one to three hours while the surgical teams observe and perform blood tests to learn how well hearts, lungs and livers function. In 2023, the biggest impact for OurLegacy was in the growth of livers used for transplant, as NRP has enabled the use of DCD livers from donors over the age of 50. Throughout 2023, NRP allowed OurLegacy to recover organs from 14 additional donors.

Centralized Care

Standardized, centralized care is critical to increasing organ availability and viability. For the last 18 months, OurLegacy has been transferring a number of donors from outlying hospitals to AdventHealth Orlando where care can be delivered more efficiently. Once there, a dedicated clinical team of physicians, nurses, respiratory therapists and transplant specialists deliver compassionate, personalized care. In 2023, nine donors were transferred to AdventHealth Orlando's hub for donor care. In 2024, we expect to open an official Donor Care Unit (DCU) with dedicated donor care bays and an organ recovery room. This DCU will be the first of its kind in Florida.

Donor Gratitude

Transplants only happen when there is a donor. OurLegacy succeeds in its mission because of the selfless generosity of donors and donor families who make the gift of life possible. AdventHealth and OurLegacy's clinical and professional teams and volunteers have profound gratitude for donors and donor families.

AdventHealth Orthopedic Institute

The AdventHealth Orthopedic Institute (AHOI) is respected as one of the top institutes in the country for overall orthopedic care. Providing both conservative non-operative and surgical care for our patients across hospital and ambulatory sites, the multidisciplinary team of therapists, athletic trainers and physicians provides subspecialized care every day and is dedicated to returning patients to optimal function and a fulfilling, active life.

New Physicians

Five physicians and three advanced practice providers joined Rothman Orthopaedics Florida in 2023.

Programs

AdventHealth Kissimmee launched an orthopedic program including non-operative care, total joint replacement, podiatry, hand surgery and general ortho. This program is in collaboration with Rothman Orthopaedics and AHMG Orthopaedic Associates of Osceola.

AdventHealth Winter Garden has added total joint replacement services to its orthopedic program. The program elevates the options available in the community through the addition of a Stryker MAKO robot to provide robotic-assisted total joint surgery.

AdventHealth Surgery Center at Innovation Tower, located across from AdventHealth Orlando, opened in late 2023. This center offers a high-quality, high-value option for the most advanced levels of musculoskeletal interventions and surgery. A joint venture between AdventHealth and physicians in the community, the surgery center offers an exceptional patient experience, without the need for a hospital admission.

Rothman Orthopaedics Florida saw over 100,000 patients in 2023. Over 40% of new patients began with a non-operative physician. This provides quicker access to an appointment and patients are appropriately assessed for the necessary level of treatment. Patients needing surgical care are then navigated to the correct subspecialty.

Orthopedic Residency Launches

AdventHealth Orlando welcomed its first residents to a newly accredited graduate medical education (GME) program in Orthopedic Surgery. Over five years of training, a total of 30 orthopedic residents will comprise the Orthopedic Surgery Residency Program, a partnership with Rothman Orthopaedics. The program earned initial accreditation from the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) and further extends the graduate medical education offerings that are available at AdventHealth Orlando, including established physician residencies in diagnostic radiology, general pediatrics, general surgery, internal medicine and OB/GYN.

The Rothman Orthopaedics at AdventHealth Florida Orthopedic Residency Program follows a mentorship-based model where residents will focus on learning from subspecialty faculty experts within numerous disciplines, including trauma and fracture care, orthopedic sports medicine, shoulder and elbow, hand and wrist, hip and knee, foot and ankle, spine, pediatric orthopedics and orthopedic oncology, amongst others. The curriculum focuses on AdventHealth's mission of delivering wholeperson care and encompasses subspecialty



didactic and Bio Skills curricula, surgical simulation training, clinical and non-clinical research platforms, and innovation programs. Rotations will follow a graduated clinical and operative schedule.

AdventHealth Neuroscience Institute

The AdventHealth Neuroscience Institute (NSI) is the largest provider of neurosurgical care in the state of Florida. With over 200 neurologists, neuro-hospitalists and neurosurgeons, NSI has expanded access to nationally ranked care while becoming a destination for high-acuity neurosurgical procedures and subspecialty neurology conditions.

New Physicians

In 2023, NSI added six new subspecialists to continue to address the growing consumer demand for both widespread and rare neurological conditions.

Program Highlights

Spine

- Establishment of spine ERAS protocol geared toward improving surgical outcomes, decreasing length of stay and reducing cost of care through pathways outlining care elements throughout a patient's perioperative journey.
- Early ambulation work instruction created and launched for postoperative spine patients leading to decreased length of stay, decreased incidence of pulmonary complications and thromboembolism, as well as improved readmission rates.
- Revamp of pre-surgical spine class now includes an inpatient and outpatient class offered in both English and Spanish. Virtual options allow more patient access to education prior to spine surgery. Participation results in clearer post-op expectations, leading to shorter length of stay, less readmissions and fewer surgical site infections.

Movement Disorders

• Fastest growing noninvasive brain surgery program (MRgFUS) in the country.

The first awake robotic deepbrain stimulation surgery in the world was completed at AdventHealth Celebration.

Stroke

 Vivistim outcomes outpacing Lancet Journal findings. This could translate to the ability to use the affected hand and arm to tie shoe laces, cut food independently, put clothes away on hangers and improve typing speed and accuracy.

After 6 weeks for occupational therapy sessions at 3x/ week, a pivot study found an average increase on the Fugl-Meyer (FMA-UE) of 5.0 points. The average from the first 12 patients seen for the same period with Vivistim VNS paired rehab is 11.25 points. The FMA-UE's minimally clinically important difference (MCID) is 5.2 points. Viz.Al Stroke was deployed across Central Florida. This Al-powered technology leverages advanced, FDA-cleared algorithms to analyze medical imaging data, providing real-time insights and automated assessments to accelerate diagnosis and treatment. This provides a platform for communication and faster intervention decision making, resulting in decreased intervention times.

Additional Programs

- Normal Pressure Hydrocephalus program revamp streamlined patient pathways and decreased time from referral to drain trial.
- A new neuro-endocrinologist completed our multidisciplinary pituitary team and elevated the program to a Center of Excellence.
- NSI launched an AdventHealth Foundation Board, with members serving as community ambassadors for fundraising priorities.

Multidisciplinary Clinics

MDCs are beneficial to help streamline care for the patient with access to several specialists in a single visit. NSI offers eight multidisciplinary clinics.

- Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS)
- Charcot-Marie Tooth (CMT)/Muscular Dystrophy Association (MDA)
- Huntington's Disease

Planned MDC expansions include Stroke, Tic/Tourette's, Palliative, Lewy Body and Neuromyelitis Optical.

Outreach
